# STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA Purchasing Division

## **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(I), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

### AMENDMENT #7

### MARSHALL UNIVERSITY

### AND

### SODEXO AMERICA, LLC

THIS AMENDMENT #7, dated September 8, 2022, is between MARSHALL UNIVERSITY ("University") and SODEXO AMERICA, LLC ("Vendor").

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, University and Vendor entered into that certain Contract # MU20DINING effective August 16, 2019, as amended ("Agreement"), whereby Vendor manages and operates the University's Food Services operation in Huntington, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to further amend the aforesaid Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Exhibit B, Subsection B, there is an average minimum number of meal plan participants required for each academic semester equal to two thousand sixty-nine (2,069) participants. For the 2021-2022 academic year, such required minimum number of meal plan participants will not be achieved, resulting in a total projected financial impact to Vendor in the amount of Five Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Nine and 42/100 Dollars (\$533,709.42). Therefore, the parties have agreed to the modifications under this Amendment #7 to minimize the financial impact to Vendor in an amount projected to be Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-One Dollars (\$220,771.00) for such meal plan participant shortfall. The Vendor has agreed to waiver the remaining shortfall of Three Hundred Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$312,938.42).
  - 2. Section 2, Term, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "2. <u>Term.</u> The effective date of this Agreement will be the fully executed signature date. The term of this Agreement will begin on August 16, 2022, ("Commencement Date") and end on August 15, 2023. At the end of the term, this Agreement will be evaluated. If the parties agree that it is a mutually beneficial relationship, the Agreement may be extended in writing for up to eleven (11) additional one (1) year periods. Time is of the essence in this Agreement. University and Vendor agree to participate in Expectations Sessions, in accordance with Exhibit E, throughout the term of this Agreement with a minimum of one (1) per contract year."
  - 3. Section 4.11 is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "4.11 <u>Compliance with Laws, Policies & Procedures.</u> To the extent applicable to the Services, Vendor shall fully comply with all federal, state, local, and University laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, policies and licenses, including applicable building policies and procedures. Vendor shall be solely responsible for ensuring that any recommendations made in connection with the Services comply with all applicable

federal, state, local and University laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures. Vendor shall be responsible to obtain and maintain any necessary liquor licenses and permits for the Joan C. Edwards Stadium and the Hoops Family Field at the Veterans Memorial Soccer Complex and in the Student Center. Vendor shall have the exclusive right to sell and serve alcoholic beverages at the following locations:

Joan C. Edwards Stadium: One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, West Virginia 25755

Student Center: 1W27 Memorial Student Center, One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, West Virginia 25755

Hoops Family Field at Veterans Memorial Soccer Complex: 2598 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Cam Henderson Arena: 1917 3rd Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Dot Hicks Field: 2202 3rd Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Vendor shall adhere to all applicable federal, state, local laws and regulations regarding the service of alcoholic beverages. Vendor shall not be obligated to serve alcoholic beverages to any person believed by any employee of Vendor to be under the legal age to consume alcohol, and shall have the right, as a condition of the serving of any alcoholic beverage, to require proof of age from any person requesting such service. Further, Vendor shall have the right to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to any person who its employees believe to be intoxicated or otherwise impaired. University shall be responsible to provide security, as necessary, during the service of alcohol."

4. Section 13 is amended to reflect a change of first address for Notices to Vendor as follows:

"To Vendor: Sodexo America, LLC

- 5. Effective retroactive to September 1, 2021, Exhibit A, Section B, (Retail Program), Subsection 2 (Commissions), Subsection a, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "a. <u>Retail Commissions</u>. Vendor shall pay University a guaranteed annual commission based on the average number of meal plan participants per academic semester as follows:

Vendor shall calculate the average number of meal plan participants per academic semester as follows: (i) actual number at the beginning of each academic semester (week 3 of each semester), and (ii) actual number at the middle of each academic semester (end of week 8 of each semester), and (iii) actual number at the end of each academic semester (last week of each semester). Vendor shall add the aforementioned actual number of meal plan participants and divide by three (3) to get the average number of meal plan participants.

As the number of meal plan participants increase and exceed the above chart thresholds, both the average number of meal plan participants and the guaranteed commission amount shall be increased as follows: for every incremental fifty (50) meal plan participants added above the 2151-2200 threshold, the guaranteed commission rate for such new threshold range shall be increased by Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars (\$11,878.00) for the Fall semester and Eleven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars (\$11,657.00) for the Spring semester, over the previous threshold range. For clarification purposes, the new range in the above Fall semester chart shall be 2201-2250, with a guaranteed commission equal to \$534,394 and for the Spring semester chart shall be 2201-2250, with a guaranteed commission equal to \$524,496.

Such commission shall be paid in accordance with Subsection 2.c below, provided that at the end of each academic year, Vendor shall reconcile the guaranteed amount against the commission amount already paid to University, and shall pay University any additional amounts due and owing, if any."

6. Effective retroactive to September 1, 2021, Exhibit A, Section E is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

### "E. Investments.

### Previous Investments.

A. <u>Previous Investment 1</u>. On or about September 1, 2017, Vendor provided funds in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine and 24/100 Dollars (\$313,669.24) for the renovation of the concourse and the purse of equipment required for the expansion of beer sales at the Joan C. Edwards Stadium ("Previous Investment 1").

B. <u>Previous Investment 2.</u> On or about March 1, 2019, Vendor provided funds in an amount not to exceed Five Million Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$5,030,000.00) for the renovation of the Towers dining hall and Student Union food

court operations and to transform the athletic concession stands graphics ("Previous Investment 2").

- C. The Previous Investment 1 and Previous Investment 2 are collectively referred to as the "Previous Investments". As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for the Previous Investments is Four Million Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Nineteen and 11/100 Dollars (\$4,072,219.11). Vendor shall reamortize the unamortized portion of the Previous Investments on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own the Previous Investments, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.
- 2. <u>Investment 1.</u> On or about June 1, 2020, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Twenty-One Dollars (\$482,021.00) for the renovation of the Robert C. Byrd biotechnology science building Food Service operations ("Investment 1"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 1. As of September 1, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 1 is Four Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Twenty One Dollars (\$482,021.00). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of Investment 1 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not Impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 1, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized In the Branded Concepts operation.
- 3. Investment 2. On or about June 1, 2020, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Dollars (\$680,004.00) for the renovation of the Harless Dining Hall ("Investment 2"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 2. As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 2 is Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Dollars (\$680,004.00). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of Investment 2 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 2, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.
- 4. Investment 3. On or about June 1, 2020, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to be used in the University's athletic operations ("Investment 3"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 3. As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 3 is One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00). Vendor shall reamortize the unamortized portion of Investment 3 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not

Impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 3, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.

- 5. <u>Investment</u> 4. On or about June 1, 2021, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) for the renovation of the Drinko Library Food Service operations ("Investment 4"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 4. As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 4 is Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of Investment 4 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 4, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.
- 6. <u>Investment 5.</u> On or about June 1, 2021, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) for the renovation of the Natural Food Service operations in the Student Recreation enter ("Investment 5"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 5. As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 5 is Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of Investment 5 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 5, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.
- 7. Investment 6. On or about June 1, 2021, Vendor was to provide to the University an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the renovation of the Simply To Go Food Service operation In the Smith Music Hall ("Investment 6"). Due to the impact of COVID-19, Vendor and University agreed that Vendor had no obligation to provide such Investment 6. As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for Investment 6 is One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of Investment 6 on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. Such amortization shall be charged as an operating expense of the Food Service. Operating expenses shall not impact Net Sales for commission purposes. University shall own Investment 6, excluding proprietary equipment and signage utilized in the Branded Concepts operation.
- 8. If prior to the complete amortization of any of the Investments under this Subsection E any of the following events occur:
  - (I) this Agreement expires or is terminated in whole or in part;
- (II) this Agreement is amended and such modification has an adverse economic Impact on Vendor; or
- (III) Vendor's procurement programs are no longer utilized (i.e. Vendor's approved vendors) for the purchase of goods in connection with the Food Services provided under this Agreement;

then University shall begin processing the payment to reimburse Vendor, on the expiration date, or within five (5) days after receipt by either party of any notice of termination under this Agreement or within ten (10) days after the occurrence of (ii) or (iii) above, the unamortized portion of each Investment University agrees to de-identify and, if applicable, remove any proprietary elements of any of the Investments as directed by Vendor."

- 7. The parties have agreed that any unused Investment funds provided to the University under Exhibit A, Section E shall be reallocated to support the Food Service operations, including the Starbucks renovation during the summer 2023 and the Chick-Fil-A renovations during the 2024-2025 academic year, with any other remaining Investment funds upon mutual agreement of the parties. All Investment funds reallocated shall continue to be amortized and have buyback protections as reflected under Exhibit A, Section E.
- 8. Effective retroactive to September 1, 2021, Exhibit A, Section F, Contributions/Fees, Subsection 1, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "1. Contribution. Within thirty (30) days of the Commencement Date of this Agreement, Vendor made a one (1) time payment to the University in an amount equal to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.000) for the University to use at its sole discretion ("Contribution"). As of August 31, 2021, the total unamortized amount for the Contribution is Four Hundred Two Thousand Seven Hundred Seventeen and 93/100 Dollars (\$402,717.93). Vendor shall re-amortize the unamortized portion of the Contribution on a straight-line basis, commencing September 1, 2021, and continuing through August 15, 2034. In the event this Agreement expires or is terminated for any reason prior to the complete amortization of the Contribution, University shall begin processing the payment to reimburse Vendor within five (5) days after receipt by either party of any notice of termination, the unamortized portion of the Contribution."
- 9. Exhibit B, Subsection A, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "A. <u>Resident Dining Program</u>. The following meal plans selected by the University shall be available to resident dining, commuter and faculty/staff patrons:
    - Resident Dining Plans:

Meal Plan A - 10 meals per week; plus \$500 Flex and 10 Anytime Meals per semester

Meal Plan B - 10 meals per week; plus \$700 Flex and 20 Anytime Meals per semester

Meal Plan C – 10 meals per week; plus \$935 Flex per semester

Meal Plan D – 14 meals per week; plus \$500 Flex and 10 Anytime Meals per semester

Meal Plan E - 14 meals per week; plus \$700 Flex and 20 Anytime Meals per semester

Meal Plan F - 14 meals per week; plus \$935 Flex per semester

Meal Plan G – 175 meals per semester; plus \$500 Flex per semester

Meal Plan H – 175 meals per semester; plus \$700 Flex per semester

Meal Plan I - 175 meals per semester; plus \$935 Flex per semester

All resident students are required to purchase one (1) of the above Meal Plans.

Unused Flex shall roll over from the Fall semester to the Spring semester, provided that the meal plan participant purchases a meal plan for the Spring semester. Any unused Flex remaining at the end of the Spring semester shall be forfeited and shall be for Vendor's account.

### Commuter and Faculty/Staff Meal Plans.

Meal Plan J - 30 meals per semester; plus \$200 Flex per semester

Meal Plan K – 50 meals per semester; plus \$100 Flex per semester

Meal Plan L – 50 meals per semester; plus \$350 Flex per semester

Meal Plan M – 50 meals per semester; plus \$600 Flex per semester

Unused block meals and Flex shall roll over from semester to semester, year to year, until such time as student is no longer enrolled with University or faculty/staff members are no longer employed by University. Any unused block meals and Flex remaining when student no longer enrolled with University or faculty/staff no longer employed by University shall be forfeited and shall be for Vendor's account.

University grants Vendor the exclusive right to provide University with meals related to meal plans, debit card points and flex points for University to resell to its students, faculty and staff at a specified rate per meal or daily rate."

- 10. Exhibit B, Subsection B, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
  - "B. <u>Dining Program Rates</u>. The following dining rates shall be in effect for the 2022-2023 academic year as follows:

Meal Plan A	\$13.92 per person, per day
Meal Plan B	\$15.28 per person, per day
Meal Plan C	\$16.24 per person, per day
Meal Plan D	\$16.07 per person, per day
Meal Plan E	\$17.43 per person, per day
Meal Plan F	\$18.38 per person, per day
Meal Plan G	\$14.88 per person, per day
Meal Plan H	\$16.31 per person, per day

Meal Plan I	\$17.74 per person, per day
Meal Plan J	\$316.59 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan K	\$330.42 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan L	\$580.42 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan M	\$830.67 per person, per plan sold

Rates for the above meal plans are based on a required minimum of two hundred fourteen (214) meal plan days for each academic year and an average minimum number of meal plan participants for each academic semester equal to two thousand sixty-nine (2,069) participants. The parties will discuss and review the required minimum number of meal plan participants and propose new language, if needed, for an amendment by December 1, 2022.

Rates for the above Meal Plans include the Flex associated with each Plan."

- 11. Exhibit B, Subsection E, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

- 12. Exhibit B is amended by adding the following as Subsection II
- "I. <u>Summer Meal Plans and Rates</u>. The following meal plans selected by the University shall be available to patrons during the Summer 2023:

### Summer 2023 Meal Plans

Meal Plan N – 30 meals per semester; plus \$200 Flex per semester Meal Plan O – 50 meals per semester; plus \$100 Flex per semester Meal Plan Q – 19 meals per semester

### Summer 2023 Meal Plan Rates

Meal Plan N	\$316.79 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan O	\$330.81 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan Q	\$13.94 per person, per day

Unused block meals and Flex shall expire at the end of the summer semester and shall be for Vendor's account.

University grants Vendor the exclusive right to provide University with meals related to meal plans, debit card points and flex points for University to resell to its students, faculty and staff at a specified rate per meal or daily rate."

13. University and Vendor subscribe to review the amended aforesaid Agreement annually. This review shall determine whether the University now has an average minimum

number of meal plan participants each academic semester equal to two thousand sixty-nine (2,069) participants. Regardless of the number of meal plan participants, the parties agree to analyze the effectiveness of the Resident Dining Program and corresponding Meal Plans and determine whether new options should be created, or other options augmented to increase meal plan participants. In addition, should the meal plan participants each academic semester equal two thousand sixty-nine (2,069) participants then the University and Vendor agree to review new and current investment strategies. This review should look for ways to upgrade or augment food service infrastructure at all locations throughout campus as mutually determined by the University and Vendor.

- All capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meanings set forth in the Agreement unless otherwise expressly provided in this Amendment.
- Unless otherwise stated herein, this Amendment #7 is effective August 16, 2022. and thereafter, unless amended. All other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect, except by necessary implication.


