<u>Campus Service Worker OSHA Refresher Training</u>: The annual training for the campus service workers is scheduled to be conducted April 19-20, 2011. Some of the health and safety topics to be covered will include blood borne pathogens, hazard communication, hazard recognition, proper lifting techniques, incident reporting, and asbestos awareness.

<u>On-Line Safety Training Development</u>: The Health and Safety Department is preparing an updated version of the On-line Defensive Driver Training which should be available in September. The On-line Biosafety training has been made available and is being utilized by faculty and staff.

<u>AON Report and Upcoming Inspections</u>: The AON Main Campus Inspection Report was made available to the members of the committee for their review.
