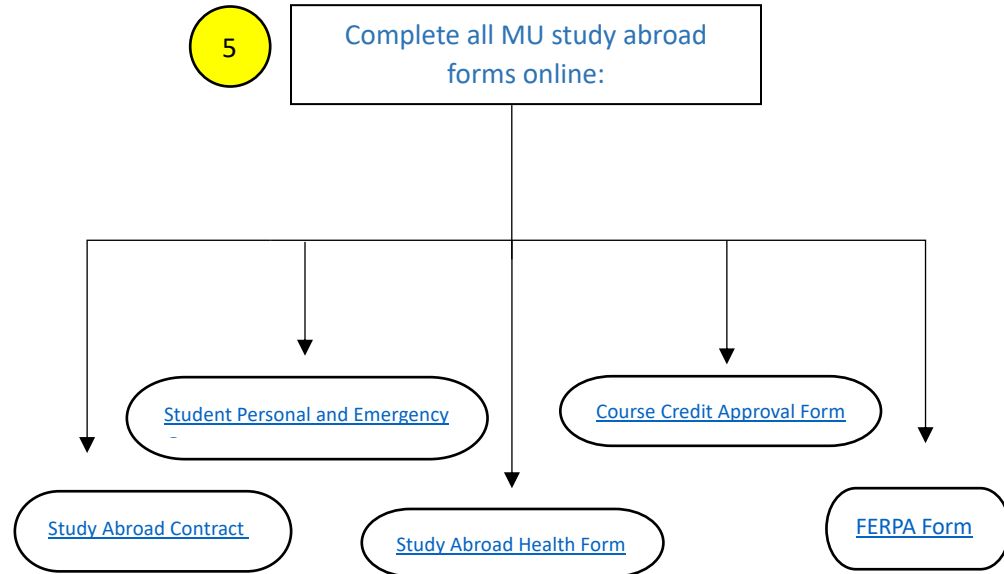


# STUDY ABROAD PROCESS

- 2 Meet up with your advisor to make sure your program credits will transfer

## Once accepted:

- 6 Obtain a VISA for the host country, if applicable. Visa determination and application process can be located at <https://travel.state.gov/content/travel.html>
- 7 Purchase international health insurance if it's not already included in your program:
- 8 Check if your program includes housing and meal plans, if they are not included then make arrangements
- 9 Pay the study abroad application fee through myMU Student Account Center.
- 10 Enroll in the Dept. of State's STEP program as a precaution. The link is: <https://step.state.gov/step/> once you enroll your travel dates and information, you will receive emails if there are any concerns for US citizens.
