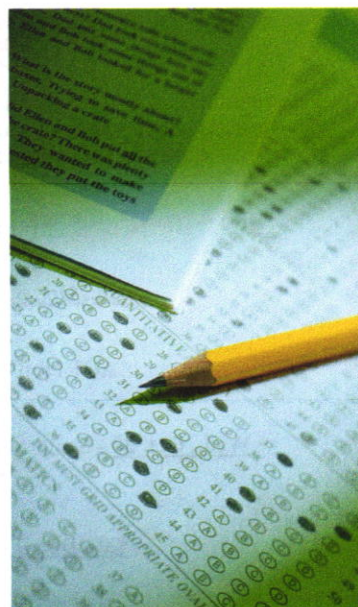

## Featured College:

### Berea College "Mountaineers"



- ♦ Berea College offers a high-quality education to bright and talented students who have limited economic resources. Founded in 1855 by ardent abolitionists and radical reformers, Berea was the first interracial and coeducational college in the South. Today, Berea College is consistently ranked as one of the leading private liberal arts colleges in the United States. Berea College earned this recognition by focusing on rigorous academic programs and graduating students with little or no student loan debt.
- ♦ Berea is the only one of America's top colleges that awards every enrolled student a no-tuition promise. The College is one of only seven federally recognized Work Colleges in the United States. Every student works 10-15 hours a week while carrying a full academic load.
- ♦ Berea College has Bachelor Degrees in 32 majors, including arts and sciences and select professional programs as well as independent, student-designed majors and a dual-degree engineering program in cooperation with the University of Kentucky.
- ♦ Berea College has an enrollment of approximately 1,600 undergraduates, representing 43 states, 2 U.S. territories and 62 countries. They also boast a very low average class size of 10 to 1.
- ♦ The Berea Term Abroad Program pays up to 75 percent of student cost.
- ♦ Berea College has 7 men and 7 women NCAA Division 3 sports and is part of the USA South Athletic Conference.



## Surprising Facts about E-Cigarettes (Vaping)

- ♦ E-Cigarettes contains the addictive substance nicotine.
- ♦ E-Cigarettes have about the same amount of nicotine as cigarettes.
- ♦ Most e-cigarettes contain and emit numerous potentially toxic substances.
- ♦ May lead to tooth decay.
- ♦ E-Cigarettes causes indoor environments to have an increase in airborne particulate matter and nicotine.
- ♦ E-Cigarettes makes you more likely to start smoking, which is extremely deadly to you and the people close to you.
- ♦ E-Cigarettes can cost between \$500 and \$2000 a year, depending on usage.
